Helpful Hints to Better Enjoy Summer at the Cottage

<u>Recipe for Pasta Tomato and Basil Salad</u> (serve it hot or cold) (Serves 8 as a side dish)

1 package 375 grams rotinni or penne (whole wheat pasta is best as it has more flavour than white pasta)

3 cloves minced garlic

4 large ripe tomatoes chopped into one inch chunks

 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup washed fresh basil chopped (you can add more to taste)

Salt and pepper to taste

1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese

Cook pasta according to package directions, drain.

In a large bowl mix together rest of ingredients and serve hot. Leftovers (if there any) can be served cold.
