The township of Rideau Lakes PITCH-IN campaign is from April 14 – 27. Help keep Otter Lake Road (and other surrounding roads) looking great by picking up roadside litter during Rideau Lakes PITCH-IN. Yellow Pitch-In bags are free to volunteers and can be obtained at the Township Office and libraries, or call and arrange to have them delivered. Pick up roadside

Have you seen an OLLA t-shirt? Want one of your own? Or perhaps you'd prefer the logo on a BBQ apron or coasters. Well now you can, and at great prices.

OLLA created a new logo that represents its ongoing commitment to preserving Otter Lake and its shorelines. In the summer of 2022 that logo was put on a few t-shirts that were worn at the AGM (and the 2023 AGM) with some members expressing interest in having their own. Those who wore the shirts bought their own, and now you can too. If you prefer to have an Otter Lake logo (without OLLA on it) that's also available. OLLA makes no profit on these but wants to increase awareness of the lake and the role we play in preserving it.

Having merchandise customised can be daunting. To make it easier OLLA has provided some standard products and an email address to send your order to. Soon the OLLA website will also have some pictures of the samples. Note that the printing on fabric requires a minimum of 12 similar items with the same LOGO ink colour. Order the quantity you want and we can combine it with other orders until we have 12 or more. Embroidery is also an option and can be ordered as a single item. Other items may vary for the minimum quantities, but you'll be notified of that when you send in your order. Payment will be required upon pick-up from an Otter Lake property. The initial price is approximated since it may fluctuate up or down depending on the total number ordered or any changes needed to the artwork to fit the product, but it gives you a rough idea of cost. You will be emailed your actual final price when the order is ready to be submitted before you make a final decision to go ahead with the order.

Currently we're offering Hoodies, Sweatshirts, T-shirts (long and short sleeve), Ball caps, BBQ Aprons, Tote bags, and Drink Coasters. Send your order and/or inquiry to ollamerchandise@otterlake.org.

location. It I also important to state that you have read and accept the contest rules.


